- The RFP for the OPAC was made publicly available on March 10th, and responses are due back on April 15th. The committee will reconvene and begin reviewing and evaluating the responses at that time. You can view the requirements document at <http://yavapai.us/bids>.
- Kelly and Chanel continue to work on the new YLN website. It is making great progress. We will be discussing the YLN logo at the Steering Committee meeting on April 8th and anticipate a decision shortly afterward. 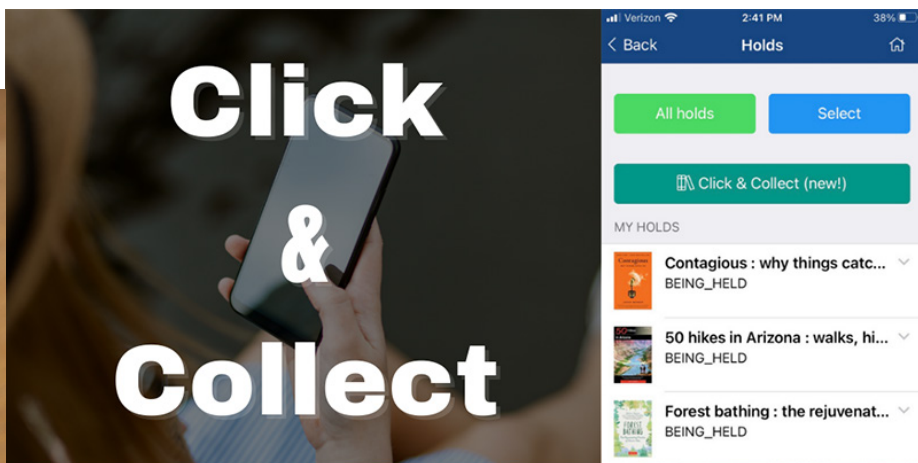

# Prioritization

## Priority One: Resolve Current Help Desk Requests

A help desk request, or work order, is the submission of a problem that one encounters during the normal operation of a YLN service. Requests are generally submitted via e-mail to help@yln.info. If a request is submitted via telephone, then a YLN staff person will create the request for the submitter. Help desk requests will always be our highest priority because in some cases a member library employee cannot complete a work function until the issue is resolved.

## Priority Two: Consider a New OPAC

There are shortcomings with our current OPAC, Enterprise, and other OPACs are doing new and interesting things. We want to consider what the other vendors have to offer.

## Priority Three: Upgrade EZProxy

EZProxy is used for database authentication. We are running a really old version. In addition, RPA is being end of life so we need to move those databases over to EZProxy.

The YLN has taken over ownership of the VMWare servers from ITS which host Symphony and Enterprise. We need to learn how to admin VMWare and be prepared for emergencies.

## Priority Eleven: Roll out Niche Academy

Niche Academy is a software product that allows anyone in the Network to create tutorial or videos for the public or for staff. You can share those videos on your website via a Niche widget.

**Goal:** Make Niche Academy available to the Network

- Test the functionality on the YCFLD website
- Go live
- Promote to the Network
- Implement at interested libraries

## Priority Twelve: Move to Message Bee

The Network has been having ongoing problems with patrons not receiving email notices because their email provider quietly rejects them. SirsiDynix has not been willing to tackle this problem. As a solution, the Network is moving to Unique MessageBee. Not only will notices be delivered reliably to patrons, they also can track whether the patron opened the email and if they clicked on links inside.

**Goal:** Move to a reliable email notice system  
**Project Lead:** Chanel Wheeler

- Get quote from Unique
- Pick pilot library
- Sign agreement with Unique
- Set up pilot library with overdue, hold, and bill notices
- Roll out overdue, hold, and bill notices to all YLN libraries
- Set up pilot library with autorenewal notice
- Roll out autorenewal notice to all YLN libraries
- Roll out notices for K-12s

## Priority Thirteen: Move Servers from Ubuntu to RHEL

Our Ubuntu servers are not playing well with the Hyper-V host. Red Hat is better supported on Hyper-V. The District and ITS already bought two RHEL licenses. The Network will be buying the rest.

**Goal:** Move servers to RHEL so they will be more stable.

- Move portal server to RHEL
- Move ylnstest server to RHEL
- Move district server to RHEL
- Move districttest server to RHEL

## Priority Fourteen Improve Database Quality

Enhance the operation of the catalog for patrons and staff by improving material description, subject and genre access, and data integrity. These tasks are for materials already in Symphony.

**Goal:** Improve patron and staff search experience

- Correct structurally invalid bibliographic records in Symphony
- Complete cataloging and descriptions of Adult Books
- Add Subject Headings and Genre Headings to bibliographic records that lack them
- Complete cataloging and description of Youth Books
- Complete cataloging and descriptions of Adult non-book materials
- Complete cataloging and description of Youth non-book materials
- Clean-up genre headings to conform to current standards
